LIVE EDUCATION

Bystander Intervention Training

Bystander Intervention Training is an in person program that uses real life video clips to educate members on how to intervene during risky situations. Topics like alcohol, drugs, hazing, and sexual misconduct are discussed.

Chapter Redevelopment Program

Chapter Culture Reset is an in person program that challenges chapters to think about values as it relates to health and safety. It gives them the opportunity to evaluate their current culture and find ways to enhance it.

Hazing Education

The Lambda Chi Alpha Hazing Education program is an in person training that uses engaging, scenario based education to talk about how to identify hazing, understand the harm that it can cause, and intervene if they see it happening.

ASTP

Lambda Chi Alpha has an in person Alcohol Skills Training Program (ASTP) that discusses standard drinks, BAC, the effects of alcohol and overall risk reduction.

Mock Trial

This in person workshop allows members to walk through real-world outcomes that could result from their decision making. With the guidance of a trained attorney, the chapter gains a deeper understanding of accountability, liability, and the importance of sound judgment in protecting themselves and their brotherhood.

Event Planning & Policy

Event Planning & Policy is an in person training that is used with chapters to support them in understanding both Lambda Chi Alpha and campus policies. It also defines an organizational event, discusses liability, and provides chapters with the opportunity to plan events and receive feedback.

Social Event Host & Liability

Social Event Host & Liability takes a deeper dive into social event planning, policy, and the liability that can come when policies are ignored. This program discusses insurance and uses real life lawsuits to help students understand how they can change the trajectory of an incident.

BYOB Event Training

BYOB Event Training is an in person training where chapters participate in a mock BYOB event. Chapter members bring the BYOB expectations to life through a real life event where members play the role of chapter brothers and guests and walk through a variety of situations.
